

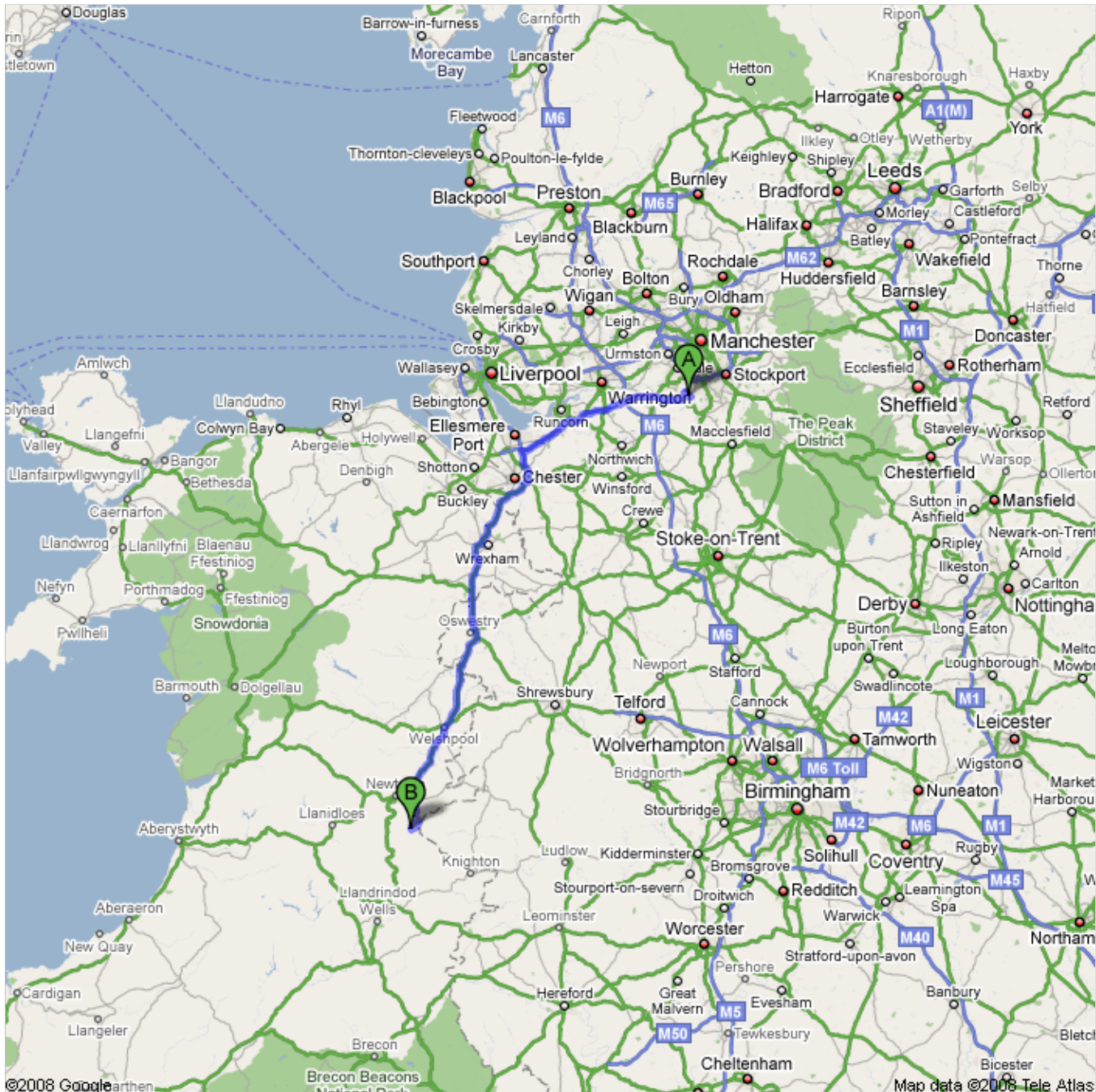


Directions to Knighton, Powys LD7 1YT, UK

94.9 mi – about 2 hours 10 mins

As you come south of Wrexham, the road becomes narrower (one lane each direction).

If you have not ordered provisions in advance, you may want to stop and pick up a few items. In the village of Pant there is a Co-operative store on the right hand side; and in the village of Four Crosses there is a Cost Cutter on the right hand side and a Spar on the left hand side; or you could detour into the town of Welshpool.




Manchester Airport

1. Head east on Toronto Ave toward Ramp Rd W	go 322 ft total 322 ft
2. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Terminal Rd N	go 0.1 mi total 0.2 mi
← 3. Slight left at Outwood Ln About 2 mins	go 0.9 mi total 1.1 mi
4. Merge onto M56 via the ramp to Chester/Warr'gton/B'ham/M6/Preston/ Liverpool/M62 About 26 mins	go 26.7 mi total 27.7 mi
5. At junction 11 , exit onto M53 toward Chester/Wrexham About 3 mins	go 2.7 mi total 30.5 mi
6. Continue on A55 (signs for Wrexham/Whitchurch) About 6 mins	go 5.6 mi total 36.1 mi
7. Take the A483 exit toward Wrexham/Chester	go 0.3 mi total 36.3 mi
8. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A483/Wrexham Rd Continue to follow A483 Go through 1 roundabout Entering Wales About 22 mins	go 16.4 mi total 52.8 mi
9. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto A5 Go through 3 roundabouts Entering England About 11 mins	go 7.2 mi total 59.9 mi
10. At Mile End Roundabout , take the 3rd exit onto A483 About 10 mins	go 5.5 mi total 65.5 mi
11. Continue on N Rd	go 0.2 mi total 65.6 mi
12. Continue on The St Entering Wales About 3 mins	go 1.6 mi total 67.3 mi
13. Continue on A483 Go through 3 roundabouts About 24 mins	go 16.7 mi total 84.0 mi
← 14. Turn left at B4386	go 0.2 mi total 84.1 mi
15. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit and stay on B4386 About 1 min	go 0.3 mi total 84.5 mi
← 16. Turn left at B4368 About 5 mins	go 3.3 mi total 87.8 mi
→ 17. Turn right at A489 About 1 min	go 299 ft total 87.9 mi
← 18. Turn left at B4368 About 2 mins	go 0.9 mi total 88.8 mi

Notice that road signs are in English and Welsh.

Step 14 on the previous page:

There is a sign indicating the castle to the right (worth a visit).



Followed immediately by the sign for the left turn onto the B4368.



Step 15 on the previous page:

This takes you into the village of Abermule.

Step 16 on the previous page:

Turn left in Abermule, over a level crossing and up the Mule Valley (twisty, narrow lane – very pretty).

Step 17 on the previous page: Junction of A489 and B4368. A ¼ mile to the left is Glanmule, where petrol, diesel, workshop services and mechanic are available at the Glanmule Garage. ¾ mile to the right is the village of Kerry, where meals are available at the Kerry Lamb. Open from 5:00pm weekdays, and 12 noon at weekends. Meals every evening except Mondays; Sunday roast at lunchtime and OAP lunch noon to 2:00pm on Fridays. The village shop and Post Office in Kerry is open 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am to 12:30pm on Saturday.

The B4368 climbs about four miles up to the Kerry Ridgeway, one of the country's ancient routes. There is a picnic area on the left of the road at the Ridgeway (picture looking back towards Kerry)



About a mile down from the Ridgeway is a lane on the right (Nancy will put a sign on the left indicating the turn to New Cwm Farm)



New Cwm Farm is the first on the right. Welcome! Enjoy your visit!
